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The *Hub Group, Inc.* class action lawsuit was filed on behalf of those who purchased or otherwise acquired *Hub Group, Inc.* ("*Hub Group*") (NASDAQ: HUBG) securities between April 28, 2023 and May 11, 2026, inclusive (the "Class Period"). Captioned *Daniel Lawler v. Hub Group, Inc.*, No. 26-cv-07596 (N.D. Ill.), the *Hub Group* class action lawsuit alleges that *Hub Group* and/or certain of its officers and/or directors violated federal securities laws by making false or misleading statements and/or omitted to disclose material information.

COMPLAINT ALLEGATION SUMMARY:

Hub Group is a transportation logistics company that provides trumping services through its two primary business segments: (1) Intermodal and Transportation Solutions; and (2) Logistics.

The complaint alleges that, throughout the Class Period, Defendants made materially false and/or misleading statements, as well as failed to disclose material facts about the company's business, operations, and prospects. Specifically, Defendants misrepresented and/or failed to disclose that: (1) the company's 2023 and 2024 financial statements contained premature and incorrect recognition of certain transactions concerning operating revenue, operating income, revenue recognition, effectiveness of internal controls, and drivers of financial results and growth; (2) the company's Q1 through Q3 2025 financial statements contained understatements of purchased transportation costs and accounts payable; and (3) as a result of the foregoing, Defendants' statements about the company's business, operations, and prospects were materially false and misleading and/or lacked a reasonable basis at all relevant times.

WHY DID HUB GROUP'S STOCK DROP?

On May 12, 2026, Hub Group announced that some of its transactions were “prematurely or incorrectly recognized or not adequately supported, causing its 2023 and 2024 annual reports to contain material misstatements. On this news, Hub Group's stock price fell 13%.

THE LEAD PLAINTIFF PROCESS:

The Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995 permits any investor who purchased or acquired *Hub Group* securities during the Class Period to seek appointment as lead plaintiff in the *Hub Group* class action lawsuit. A lead plaintiff is a representative party that acts on behalf of other class members in directing the litigation. In order to be appointed lead plaintiff, the Court must determine that the class member's claim is typical of the claims of other class members, and that the class member will adequately represent the class. Your ability to share in any recovery is not, however, affected by the decision whether or not to serve as a lead plaintiff. Filling out the online form above or communicating with any counsel is not necessary to participate or share in any recovery achieved in this case. Any member of the purported class may move the court to serve as a lead plaintiff through counsel of his/her choice, or may choose to do nothing and remain an inactive class member.
